

Sixteen large historic maps; 23 beautiful works of art showing landmarks by leading artists. The Chiswick Timeline celebrates the history of a part of London that was once a village west of the capital on the banks of the River Thames. Hand crafted in vitreous enamel, this landmark work of art is situated under the railway bridges outside Turnham Green tube station.
